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Start of Season preparation

Club registration links should now be open for players, coaches and team managers

- Please ensure everyone registers using their club specific link
- If a participant is both a player and coach/team manager, they will need to complete registrations for both
- Registrations close 30th June

Once participants have registered, they will need to be allocated to their teams

- If players are playing in multiple teams, they can be allocated to both



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Game Day Officials

A key role for the Team Manager is finding helpers!

At the start of a season, it can be helpful to create a game day officials' roster to assist with team duties such as scoring.

Game day positions to be filled are:

- Scorer (Home games & Midweek games)
- Timekeeper (Away games)
- Primary Carer (both Midweek & Saturday)

Pre-Game Responsibilities

Home Game	Away Game/Midweek Game
Pre-match Safety Checklist (Complete at beginning of day with opposition)	Pre-match Safety Checklist (Complete at beginning of day with opposition)
Set up courts with Post pads, bench seating etc	Bring first aid kit and warm up equipment
Ensure Ice is available	Ensure all players are listed on team sheets
Ensure Game Ball is pumped up	Write in starting positions
Place scoresheets & other match paperwork into clipboards	
Bring clipboards out for each game	
Ensure all players are listed on the team sheet & first quarter positions listed	*Teams listed first in Midweek competitions are required to supply the game ball



During and Post Game

- Inform score bench of starting positions and any substitutions made throughout the game (all positions should be listed)
- End of game – ensure media votes are completed and handed in with scoresheet
- Collect paperwork/equipment and clear the bench area
- Administrator or team managers enter results into PlayHQ

Team Manager Check List

Equipment kit:

- First aid kit
- Primary carer vest
- Match day netball
- Warm up netballs
- Second set of bibs (rolling subs & blood rule)

Paperwork Kit (for each court):

- AFL Barwon Handbook
- Match Day paperwork
 - Scoresheet
 - Match management paperwork
 - League vote card
 - Club media votes
- Match day envelope
- Pens!



Match Day Paperwork

Home Game (Saturday):

- At a home game it is your club's responsibility to ensure all the match day paperwork is completed
- All paperwork must be enclosed in the match day envelope and returned to AFL Barwon by Monday 9am

Away Game:

- You need to ensure all players are listed on the scoresheet prior to the beginning of the game, and that 'Best on Courts' for your team are provided to the home team
- Please also ensure a timekeeper has been provided by your club for the game

Team Selections each week

- Team selections for game day will need to be entered into PlayHQ prior to scoresheets being printed
 - This can be completed by team managers, coaches or club admins
- For the Saturday competition, this needs to be completed by Thursday 6pm each week
- For the midweek competition, this needs to be completed by 6pm the night before game day (Mondays and/or Thursdays)

Scoresheets

- Players need to be selected each week to appear on the scoresheet
- TMs ensure all players listed on scoresheet **prior** to start of game. Players can be handwritten on scoresheet before game starts if required.
- A player **may not** be added to scoresheet after the game has commenced.
- TMs inform scorers of positional changes during quarters/breaks.



Score Bench configurations

The directive from AFL Barwon regarding score bench compositions is as follows:

- HOME TEAM: official scoresheet & position tracking
- AWAY TEAM: timer & electronic scoreboard

Example 2:

- HOME TEAM: official scoresheet
- AWAY TEAM: timer & electronic scoresheet
- HOME TEAM: live scoring & position tracking



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Positional Changes

How to inform scorers of positional changes during quarters and in breaks:

- **Option 1: Paper Slips**
 - Similar to finals substitution slips
- **Option 2: Whiteboard**
 - Reduce paper waste



World Netball Changes

1. Rolling substitutions
2. Goal after whistle
3. Centre pass checks
4. Toss up removal
5. Short pass
6. Player safety
7. Foul play
8. Game management
9. Advantage
10. Contact
11. Playing the ball
12. Throw-in



Competition Rule updates

- **World Netball changes will be implemented for Winter 2024 season**
- **Long sleeve tops can be worn by all players (senior and junior)**
 - **Some clubs have already adopted long sleeve uniform and sent us proofs of options**
 - **Please send through proofs to Sophie & Sean if getting a formalised long sleeve**
- **Clarification: 19&U age group classed as a junior competition**
