<p>The role has a mandatory attendance at the following events:</p> <p><b>Weekly Training</b></p> <p>Coaches are to prepare and execute weekly training sessions to prepare players for upcoming tournaments.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. Barwon Junior Netball Championships – Feb-May 2023</b> Barwon Junior Netball Championships will return next year. This is a weekly competition held on a Monday night starting in February 2023 (5 or 10 weeks plus finals). Teams will play against Association or League representative teams in the area (Geelong FNL, Bellarine FNL, Geelong &amp; District FNL, Geelong Central NA, Colac &amp; District FNL, Ballarat FNL)</li> <li><b>2. Central West Association Championships – Sunday 4 June, Altona Netball Association</b> Association Championships is a day tournament where our leagues will compete to qualify for the final’s day. All teams and coaches are expected to be available and compete in this tournament.</li> <li><b>3. Association Championship Finals Day – Sunday 18 June, State Netball Centre</b> If teams qualify during the Central West Association Championships tournament, they will compete at the finals day to be crowned Champions of the region.</li> </ol>

### KEY ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

The role includes, but is not limited to, the following duties. In many cases, a duty will necessitate consultation with the Netball Coordinator and Netball Operations Manager.

WORK REQUIREMENTS & RESPONSIBILITIES	
1.	Participate as a member of the team Selection Panel for your appointed team.
2.	Adhere to all league policies and guidelines.
3.	Develop the team training program including skill development sessions, in line with player workloads and availability
4.	Provide coaching instruction to team members in the areas of technique, specialist positional skills and team skills.
5.	Identify and maximise underlying potential to deliver long term growth in individual athletes.
6.	Evaluate and assess individual and team performance, ensuring individuals are appropriately challenged, and provided with constructive feedback.
7.	Take appropriate action to ensure that underperformance is effectively dealt with.
8.	Develop, implement, and adapt match play strategies.
9.	Team coaches will supervise and mentor assistant coaches in both the training and competition environment.
10.	Communicate clearly, concisely and with a high level of integrity to both the player and parent group.
11.	Current Working with Children's Check required.
12.	Hold Minimum DEVELOPMENT Level coaching accreditation or be willing to obtain.
