Team selection, Starting Line-Up & Team Substitution Information (For All Finals)

The starting line-up for each team must be selected in PlayHQ by midday **Wednesday**.

NEW 2025: Starting positions MUST be **selected in PlayHQ by 6pm** the day before scheduled play. Any changes after this time must be communicated at the Competition Office on game day.

Starting line ups may be amended on PlayHQ until 6pm prior to game day. Any changes after this time must be communicated and signed off on match day to an AFL Barwon official who can be found at the office.

For **Grand Final** - teams must be selected online on PlayHQ by **COB Tuesday**. Starting positions must be in PlayHQ by Friday 6pm. Any changes post this must be communicated to AFL Barwon staff at the office.

Substitution slips will be available for collection at the office and at the courts.

The team substitution form needs to be filled out for each substitution made during the match and at quarter breaks (including injury substitutions).

Team Check In

A representative from each team must check in at least 30 mins before each game to ensure:

- All players are on the scoresheet,
- Starting positions as submitted on PlayHQ
- Bench Officials Information is correct.

Any changes that may need to be made must be communicated and approved by an AFL Barwon official.

Team Officials – **Changes for 2025**

Bench officials for each team to be submitted before finals via the **provided template by the Monday 1st September** - [Spreadsheet Download here](#)

Only the listed Team Officials are allowed on the bench with the five substitutions.

Bench officials consist of Coach, Assistant/Co-Coach, Team Manager, Primary Carer and Other (i.e. additional medical professional).

Any changes to the bench officials list must be communicated to an AFL Barwon official prior to the commencement of each game.

Scoring & Timekeeping

An independent scorer will be allocated to every final by AFL Barwon in addition to club scorers.

Independent Scorer will be the official scorer – *All clubs will be asked to nominate scorers to be allocated to the roster for independent scorers. The roster will be worked around clubs and teams playing.*

The Independent Scorer will be responsible for the scoresheet – goals and attempts tracking, centre pass tracking etc.

Participating Clubs will need to provide a check scorer/timer for each game.

- a. The home team will provide the scoreboard operator
- b. The away team will provide a timekeeper.

Position Tracking

- c. **The Home Team check scorer will look after home team position tracking.**
- d. **The Away Team check scorer will look after away team position tracking.**

LIVE SCORES will be available for all A Grade Finals.

Clubs will be responsible for their own first aid, taping etc. during finals as per a normal match day. Ice will be available at the Netball office.

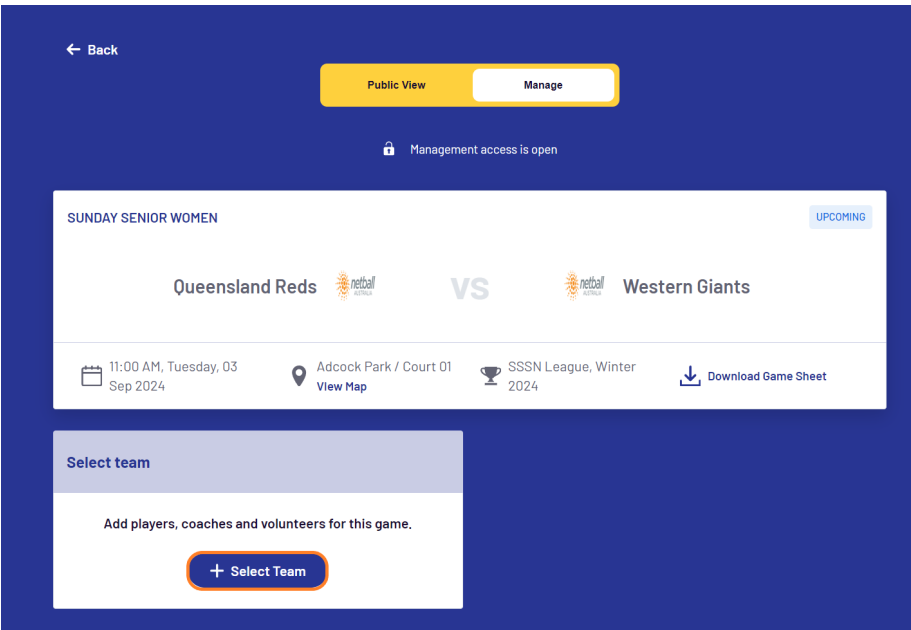
On Grand Finals Day a first aid provider will also be in attendance.

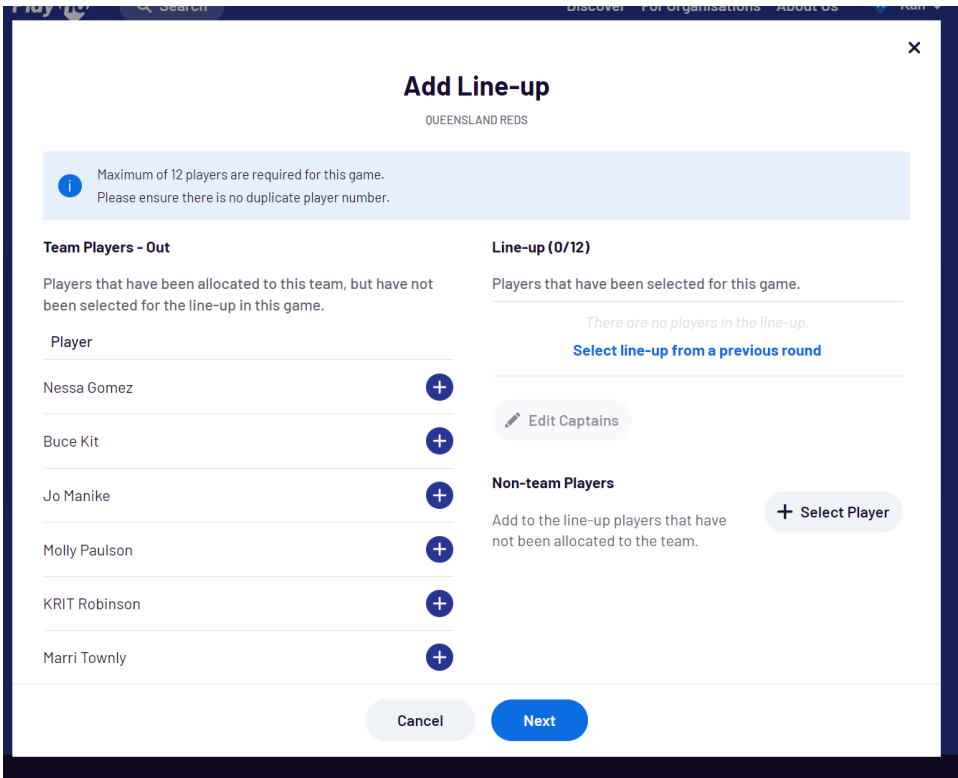
